

**PUBLIC NOTICE
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FUNDING
FY 2016-2017**

The City of Chattanooga will host a public meeting on Tuesday, April 19, 2016, from 5:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., at the Development Resource Center, 1250 Market Street, Room 1A regarding its Annual Action Plan for Program Year 2016 with U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) funds. The City is expected to receive: \$1,655,373 CDBG, \$854,868 HOME, \$148,145 ESG, and \$284,373 program income for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2016. All funds are contingent upon final approval by HUD. The FY 2016-2017 funding recommendations are as follows:

Community Development Administration

CDBG: \$355,875; HOME: \$85,485; ESG: \$11,168
Administration, management, and monitoring.

Community Development Debt Service

CDBG: \$430,000
Section 108 loan debt service.

ECD Housing and Community Development

CDBG: \$664,498
Development and preservation of affordable rental and homeowner housing, demolition, and sidewalks within the City of Chattanooga.

ECD Homeless Outreach Housing Coordinator

CDBG: \$35,000
Assisting homeless with obtaining permanent housing.

CCHDO Roofing Program

CDBG: \$160,000
Roof replacements and repairs to qualified homeowners.

Family Promise

CDBG: \$25,000
Support for centralized intake case manager.

Chattanooga Homeless Coalition Continuum of Care (COC)

CDBG: \$25,000
Support to complete the Continuum of Care planning and application process.

Chattanooga Homeless Coalition

CDBG: \$34,000
25% match for the McKinney-Vento funding for the HMIS system.

Habitat for Humanity Brushed With Kindness

CDBG: \$50,000
Minor home rehabilitation for qualified homeowners.

CHDO Set Aside

HOME: \$104,231
Required CHDO set aside to fund qualified CHDO development projects.

ECD Affordable Housing Projects

HOME: \$665,152
Development and rehabilitation of affordable rental and homeowner housing through ongoing RFP process.

Hamilton County Health Department

ESG: \$30,000
Homelessness prevention and rapid re-housing

Chattanooga Community Kitchen

ESG: \$10,000
Triage and HMIS licenses.

Chattanooga Room in the Inn

ESG: \$12,000
Housing stabilization and HMIS licenses.

Family Promise

ESG: \$25,118
Support for housing stabilization case manager.

Youth and Family Development

ESG: \$28,118
Rapid re-housing and case management.

Partnership for Families, Children and Adults

ESG: \$22,500
Domestic violence emergency shelter, prevention services, and case management.

Partnership for Families, Children and Adults

ESG: \$10,000
Emergency shelter and rapid re-housing for homeless families.
