




Greenway Goals:


47th to 55th

- One-way car traffic southbound
- Two-way ped/bike lane
- Stop signs on cross-streets
- No bollards





- Two-way car alley traffic
- Two-way ped/bike traffic
- Stop signs on cross-streets
- Bollards between 41st/42nd, 43rd/44th, and 46th/47th






Ochs Hwy to the Incline

- Concrete shared-use pathway parallel to the roadway
- Rebuild intersection at Ochs and St. Elmo Ave. with new ped signal for safer crossings
