



City of Chattanooga Water Quality Credits

NPDES Permits (up to 20%)

Requirements:

1) Properties with 3 ERUs or more.

- * A maximum of 15% credit can be given to properties that have an NPDES Stormwater Permit in *good standing, with no major violations to Stormwater regulations, for the last 12 months.*
- * A maximum of 20% credit can be given to properties that have an NPDES Stormwater Permit in *good standing and have exceeded the NPDES permit requirements, with no major violations to Stormwater regulations, for the last 12 months.*

Required Documents:

- * Completed NPDES Credit Application (Form N):

- * Annual Training records (for training conducted within the last 12 months) for Stormwater Pollution Prevention and/or Spill Control and Countermeasures.
- * Annual Visual (and Analytical if required) Monitoring records for the last 12 months.
- * Certificate of Non-Stormwater Discharge.
- * State or federal NPDES inspection reports (if inspected by such regulators within the past 12 months).
- * Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) including site drainage map.
- * Any other annual NPDES self-evaluation/auditing materials.

DISCLAIMER:

- * It is the responsibility of the User to apply for fee credits and to provide the necessary substantiating information with the credit application.
- * The City shall not be responsible for initiating applications, performing engineering calculations, or otherwise providing technical information with the preparation of credit applications.
- * Credit can be revoked or reduced at any time that it is determined by the City that the property stormwater plans, stormwater control structures, or other BMPs are not performing to the credit standard, that the qualified control structures are not being maintained to function as designed, or that the qualified control structures no longer meet the purpose of the credit.
- * To receive credits, all properties must be in compliance with all city requirements and State of TN stormwater regulations.
